## EXERCISE TIP OF THE MONTH

### JUMP SQUATS

Jumping squats work your entire lower body and they are amazing for building muscle and burning fat. This exercise will really get your heart racing.

Do four (4) sets of as many reps as you can do.

How to do a Jump Squat: Stand with your feet hip-width apart, toes forward; lightly touch your fingers behind your ears and extend your elbows to the sides. Bend your knees, then explosively jump as high as you can. Land softly on the balls of your feet and immediately lower into your next squat.
